

<b>INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER</b> The following are instructions on how to vote your ballot. Please follow these instructions precisely, otherwise, your ballot may not be counted. 1. Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot. 2. TO VOTE, you must darken the oval (●) completely. 3. To vote for a WRITE-IN candidate, write in the name on the line provided AND darken the oval completely.  4. Do NOT cross out or erase. If you make a mistake, contact the County Clerk's office at (402) 439-2222 for instructions. 5. Place voted ballot into the brown return envelope. Write your NE driver's license or state ID in the space provided on the envelope, or enclose a photocopy of an acceptable photo ID or Reasonable Impediment Certification (if applicable). Complete, SIGN and seal the envelope. Remember to moisten both seals to cover the voter ID and signature boxes. 6. Do NOT place more than ONE (1) voted ballot into the return identification envelope. 7. Return Ballot by mail, drop box, or hand delivery to County Clerk's office. 8.
